2022/23 – Council Taxes – comparison with Hawkhurst.

This note is a factual aide to our budget setting, and is not in support of any particular settlement.

This year we are mid-table for parish precepts, but the lower end of the bigger parishes.

What would be reasonable comparators? Whilst Sandhurst and Cranbrook & Sissinghurst are our near neighbours - what others might be similar in size?

£10,000 on the precept adds £4.76 to a Band D property.

£1 on a Band D property produces £2,100 extra income for the Parish.

The above figures are based on using this year's tax base. Note: a new tax base will be issued in December – which will reflect the latest number of houses that are paying Council Tax in the Parish.
