1) S137 Grant applications - following a debate the following was agreed

- Hawkhurst Fete Committee support with £500 and opportunity for joint working with the Jubilee Committee
- Community Fridge worthy project and access to other funding £100
- 10K and 5K run worthy project with potential to make a profit and support the KGV - £250
- HCSG worthy project in need of support £500

Uplands Community College - £0 Hawkhurst Fete Committee - £500 HCT 2018 Community Fridge - £100 HCT 2018 10k 5K run - £250 HCSG - £500
